Subject-Specific Examination Regulations

for the Continuing Education Master's Program in Open Design

On the basis of § 17, Para. 1, Point 3 of the Constitution of the Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin dated October 24, 2013, (Official Bulletin of the Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin No. 47/2013), the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Philosophy III issued the following examination regulations* on 31.03.2014:

§ 1 Scope of application

(1) These examination regulations contain the subject-specific regulations for the continuing education Master's program in Open Design. They apply in conjunction with the subject-specific course regulations for the continuing education Master's program in Open Design and the General Admission, Course and Examination Regulations of the Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin (ZSP-HU), as amended.

(2) The continuing education Master's program in Open Design is offered jointly by the Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin (HU) and the Universidad de Buenos Aires (UBA), and leads to a joint degree from these partner institutions.

§ 2 Designated period of study

The designated period of study for the continuing education Master's program in Open Design is four semesters.

§ 3 Examination board

The Examination Board for Archeology, Gender Studies and Cultural History and Theory is responsible for examination matters relating to the

continuing education Master's program in Open Design.

§ 4 Master's thesis

Master's theses that have been awarded a pass must be defended.

§ 5 Free examination attempts (*Freiversuche*)

(1) Passed final module examinations for which students register during the designated period of study may be repeated once in order to improve the grade.

(2) The option to repeat an examination under Para. 1 is limited to two final module examinations.

§ 6 Final grade

(1) The final grade for the continuing education Master's program in Open Design is calculated based on the grades for the final module examinations and the grade for the master's thesis, weighted according to the credit points awarded for the modules and the final module in line with the annex. The exceptions are: Module 3 Experiments and Module 5 Projects are given a weighting of 5 CP each.

(2) Final module examinations that are not graded or are merely recorded as "passed" in the absence of a comparable grading system for the transfer of credits, and the credit points awarded for the corresponding modules are not taken into consideration for the calculations in accordance with Para. 1.

§ 7 Academic degree

The academic degree *Master of Arts (M.A.)* is conferred on students who successfully complete the continuing education Master's program in Open Design. This is awarded as a double degree with two degree certificates, one from the Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin and one from the Universidad de Buenos Aires.

§ 8 Effective date

These examination regulations will take effect on the day after their publication in the Official Bulletin of the Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin.


